Cell Phone Policy:

- Teachers are working with students on the no cell phone use while learning in class
- Students that continue to have their learning obstructed because of cell phone use will be referred to administration

Personal Digital/Electronic Devices:

- Under the DSBN's Policies <u>"Education Programs and Student Services D-01: Digital Technology</u> <u>Use by Students"</u> states:
- a) If the device is to be present in the classroom the purpose is solely educational and with teacher's direction and permission.
- b) The use of this device must not interfere with anyone's learning.
- c) To protect the privacy and safety of students and staff, personal electronics CANNOT be used to take photographs or videotape, unless under the direct supervision of a teacher for academic purposes.

- d) Students should not be using their personal phones to call/text without teacher knowledge.
 Contact with parents must always happen through the office to ensure student safety.
- \circ e) Devices are never to be used in private areas such as change rooms and washrooms.
- *f*) When devices are not in use, they must be turned off and stored in a secure location (i.e., locker, backpack) DSBN schools and staff will not be held responsible for damage, loss or theft of personal electronic devices.
