Student Activity Fees and Registration Forms:

This is a reminder to students & families that have not yet completed the required consent forms through School Cash Online, or not yet paid the required \$40 registration fee.

Step 1: Complete the following forms on School Cash Online (You can access School Cash Online on our website at http://govsimcoe.dsbn.org):

- Digital Citizenship Agreement and Information Technology Consent
- □ Consent for Participation in (DSBN Curricular) Phys Ed, Intramural/Athletic Programs
- □ Informed Consent for Participation in Technology
- □ Informed Consent for Participation in the Sciences
- □ Informed Consent for Participation in Family Studies

Step 2: Payment of Student Activity Fees can also be completed using the school cash online feature (which is a secure and reliable link):

Student Activity Fee - used to support various activities and services that enhance the student experience outside of the classroom and foster school community, such as guest speakers, assemblies, special spirit days, experiential learning, extracurricular activities, etc.

Lockers:

Students were assigned lockers today through their homeroom teachers. If you would like to purchase a lock, you can purchase one from the main office for \$5 cash.
