# Information for Students Regarding Exams January 2020

#### **Exam Preparation**

- You will receive an exam overview for each course no later than Monday, January 13<sup>th</sup>.
- Organize your time and notes so that you can prepare for your up-coming exams. If you need support, please speak with your teacher/s.
- Sleep and nutrition are two important factors each day, but especially leading into your exams. Make sure you are eating
  properly and getting adequate rest. This will assist you in organizing your time, reviewing your course work and preparing
  for your exam/s.

#### **Locker Clean-Out**

• Locker clean-out will take place on **Wednesday, January 22<sup>nd</sup>**. There will be extra garbage cans in the hallways during this time. Please remove all items and keep only those that will be needed throughout the exam period. All textbooks, novels and class resources must be returned to the appropriate teachers. All library books must be returned prior to the start of exams.

#### **Transportation**

• School buses will be running on their regular schedule during the exam period. The last day for busing will be Wednesday, January 29<sup>th</sup>. The library will remain open for you to work and study while you wait for your school bus. You are permitted to leave school each day after you have completed your exam obligations.

#### **Cafeteria Services**

• The cafeteria will be open on **Thursday**, **January 23**<sup>rd</sup> and then **will be closed during the remainder of the exam period**. If you are staying for the day to work and study in the library, please bring a lunch.

#### **Inclement Weather Conditions**

• Inclement weather conditions can impact the opening of schools and/or the running of transportation. If we are experiencing inclement weather conditions, you need to be checking our school or DSBN website for updates. Notification will also be communicated through local radio stations.

### Exams

• You must remain for a minimum of 1 hour for each exam. At the 1-hour mark, teachers may excuse students who have completed their exams. Students who leave are permitted to go to their lockers quietly and then leave school property or report to the library. Students are not permitted to gather on the second or third floor of the school. Please be respectful of your peers who are still writing during this time.
