# Important Dates:

- □ May 10th All potential grads are asked to have the *Application to Graduate & Student Profile* completed by this date. See link below.
- **May 11th -** Deadline date to submit your nomination for Valedictorian
- □ May 13th MUST submit your graduation photo by midnight!
- □ May 15th 20 Community Hours must be submitted through Hour Republic to the Guidance Office by this date in order to participate in a June graduation.
- **May 17th -** Plan on returning? You must submit an application to return. See below.
- □ June 24th & June 25th Outdoor Graduate Celebration and family photo (as outlined per Public Health guidelines).

# Reminder to Complete your Student Profile

#### Valedictorian

It is time for you to nominate individual(s) to be your class valedictorian! Before nominating an individual please make sure that he/she would be willing to accept the nomination.

The process:

- Nominations for Valedictorian consideration are available now and due to be submitted no later than Wednesday, May 11th. Once the nomination process is complete, you will receive another email with the Valedictorian Voting Form.
- 2. Awards Committee meets to solidify nominee list.
- 3. Students vote for Class Valedictorian.

Must meet all four criteria:

- 1. Excellent attendance
- 2. Strong commitment to academics
- 3. Positive role model for peers
- 4. Respect for self, peers, staff and community
- 5. Co-curricular involvement (clubs, teams, etc.)

# Outdoor Graduation Celebration - June 24th & 25th

Closer to the date we will send out a form where you can sign in to a pick-up time. The plan is to distribute Grad Gowns (gown, cap, and sash that are yours to keep) when you arrive. At the Outdoor Graduation Celebration you will don your graduation gown, and then proceed to receive your diploma, and pick up your graduate package. There will be an opportunity to have your photo taken with family members (# of people permitted will be determined by Public Health).
