Dear students and families of Governor Simcoe Secondary School,

We hope that you are having a safe and relaxing Spring Break.

The Ministry of Education has notified us that schools will be closed for regular education in-person learning starting on Monday April 19.

We are moving to a model of Period 1, 2, 3, 4 rotating for the duration of online learning. Below are the online schedules for the next 2 weeks:

While schools remain physically closed, students will be participating in daily synchronous learning through Microsoft Teams or Google Classrooms. Starting on April 19, it is very important that students log into their assigned class at the time **instructed by your teacher** to participate in your daily learning. Secondary schools will continue to follow the daily schedule posted with one course a day and teachers will provide synchronous and asynchronous learning opportunities for students. For our school, classes will run from 9:55 to 1:55.

Student Online Attendance

Students are required to participate daily for attendance to be recorded.

Specialty programs

- Coop students in consultation with their teacher, parents and employer **may continue** attending their placements - more details to be shared by your co-op teacher
- Home Build students will not be participating in the Home Build and will receive directions from their teacher
- Dig IT students will be online and will receive directions from their teacher
- Niagara Link students will be online and will receive directions from their teacher
- Connecting to College programs will continue online as usual
- Alternative Education programs will transition to online learning and students will receive directions from their teacher
- eLearning courses continue as usual
