Covid Health and Safety Information

Daily Covid Screening

- All staff and students must self-screen everyday before attending school.
- Students can find the self-screening tool in their DSBN portal.
- Anyone experiencing symptoms identified by the COVID-19 screening tool must not attend school and seek appropriate medical attention.

Masks

- Wearing masks has been mandated for all secondary students and staff by the Ministry of Education.
- If you have a medical condition that prevents you from wearing a mask, please contact your school principal for details.

Signage

Follow the Health and Safety signage posted throughout the school.

Physical Distancing and Congregating

• As much as possible, students are required to maintain physical distancing and not congregate.

Hand Hygiene Practices

- Reminders to wash hands regularly will be posted throughout the school.
- Hand sanitizer will be available in every classroom and at entrances.

If there is a COVID case in your class

- If you are identified by Niagara Region Public Health (NRPH) as a close contact, there will be different protocols for self-isolation depending on your vaccination status.
- If you are fully vaccinated and asymptomatic, NRPH will likely allow you to continue to attend school.

School Day Details

Arriving in the morning

- Classrooms will be open 15 minutes before classes start.
- If you are walking/being dropped off, please don't arrive more than 15 minutes before classes
- The school schedule will be as follows:

Periods 1 and 3	8:10 a.m 10:40 a.m.
Announcements	10:40 a.m 10:50 a.m.
Lunch	10:50 a.m 11:30 a.m.
Periods 2 and 4	11:30 a.m 2:00 p.m.
Announcements & Dismissal	2:00 p.m 2:10 p.m.

• This accounts for the weekly schedule for 2 periods a day. As a reminder, the calendar for the first few months is attached to this email.

Lunches and Breaks

- Students will have one 10 minute break during both the morning and afternoon periods. Breaks will occur in different groups (at slightly different times) to minimize the congregation of students.
- Lunch will be 40 minutes long and will occur for all students from 10:50 a.m. 11:30 p.m. Students will be assigned eating areas according to grade:

Grades 9 and 10	Cafeteria
Grade 11	English Classrooms (rooms 141 A-E)
Grade 12	Learning Commons (Library)

- We are encouraging all students to spend time outside on their lunch breaks. The main floor of the school will remain open during the lunch period, but floors 2 and 3 will be closed.
- Students will be required to clean their lunch area after use.

End of the Day

• Student dismissal will be staggered according to grade in order to minimize the congregation of students.

Lockers

• Students will be assigned lockers according to their homerooms.

Grade 9 Tours

• On Tuesday, September 7th and Wednesday, September 8th during period 1, our Link Crew Student Leaders will be providing grade 9 students with tours of the school. This will happen in small groups at different times of the day (teachers have been given a schedule). Any other students new to Governor Simcoe are welcome to join the tours on Wednesday September 8th. Teachers will provide further direction on this.
