Please make sure your child's immunization record or exemption information is up-to-date with Public Health.

This school year, Public Health will be doing its <u>annual review of student immunization records</u>. You will only receive an immunization reminder notice if Public Health has incomplete vaccination information on file for your child.

How to confirm your child's vaccination information is complete:

Review and update your child's immunization record on Immunization Connect (ICON)

- Make sure all the vaccinations they have received are listed. If some are missing, add them.
- Check the Immunizations Needed section. If you child is missing vaccine(s), <u>get them vaccinated</u>. Once received, add them to your child's immunization record in ICON. Health care providers do not do this for you.

If you previously submitted an <u>exemption</u>, make sure you followed the process for school aged children. Child care exemption forms expire when your child enters school in September.
