Join us for a fun-filled adventure that proves just how much we all have to learn from one another. Don't miss this unforgettable, toe-tapping experience!



Governor Simcoe will be hosting DELF exams (DELF standing for "Diplôme d'Études en Langue Française" and is an official, internationally recognized diploma awarded by the French Ministry of Education to certify French language proficiency for non-native speakers, covering levels A1 to B2) this week on Monday, April 7th - Wednesday, April 9th during the afternoon periods. Students involved in DELF will be signed out of their afternoon classes.
