DELFF

Governor Simcoe will be hosting DELF exams (DELFF standing for "Diplôme d'Études en Langue Française" and is an official, internationally recognized diploma awarded by the French Ministry of Education to certify French language proficiency for non-native speakers, covering levels A1 to B2) on Monday, April 7th - Wednesday, April 9th during the afternoon periods. The Centre for Addiction and Mental Health (CAMH) is excited to launch **Youth-Vaping, Substance use, and Technology (VAST)**. Youth-VAST is a program for youth in Ontario who are using vaping, substances, or feel like technology is taking up too much of their time. This program brings together existing and new resources across CAMH to deliver virtual services directly to youth and their family.

- Program offered for youth ages 12-21 years.
- Appointments are offered virtually for youth all over Ontario
- Youth will be assigned a care coordinator to create a customized treatment plan
