- We are asking that every parent/guardian submit this permission form.
- If you do not approve of the courses your student has submitted in Xello and you would like to make some changes, please email Mrs. Stewart (cara.stewart@dsbn.org) or Mr. Tope (tim.tope@dsbn.org) with the specific changes that you would like to make, and Mr. Tope or Mrs. Stewart will make the adjustments for you.
- Please email only Mrs. Stewart or Mr. Tope, not both of them.
- Once they have made the changes, they will email you to let you know, and then you can use the School Cash Online form to grant approval of the updated course selections.
