1. Student Council:

- Spirit week in February (14th 17th)
- Goal is to have different themes/more creative ideas making it more fun and more inclusive
- Putting things together in the last few months while things open up -i.e., grade wars, pep rallies,
- <u>Semi-formal</u> and prom plan this as things open up leaning more towards semi-formal as more inclusive to more students
- Student outreach through social media trying to increase the presence and involvement of students and parents
- SOS (Simcoe Outreach Society) Raising money through pizza sales to give to Ukraine (food, water, medical)

2. School updates:

- COVID absences and reporting tool to NRPH
- No longer reporting unless we have 30% absenteeism through illness
- No "working from home/online" option (this was a temporary solution for January while culminating and end-of-semester tasks were being done)
- remote/online school is at capacity no further enrollments
- March Break 14th 18th
- PD Day Equity and Inclusivity using appropriate language (modelling), supporting students, pronouns, interrupting bias, etc., (can share student poem)- great feedback from staff

3. Progress Reports & Parent-Teacher Interviews:

- Sent home electronically on March 10th student's emails
- Parent-teacher interviews will be done through a sign-up (communicating through a Google Form) and teachers have 2 weeks to set up phone interviews or virtual online meetings
