Students are required to complete an in-person FCA/Final Exam on January 22-27 if they are enrolled in the courses listed below. Courses indicated with an asterisk * have performance based FCA's requiring individual student performances. As a result, individual student time slots/performance expectations may vary. These teachers will communicate attendance expectations directly with the student and parent/guardian. Teachers may also require students to attend on January 22-27 to complete outstanding course expectations. Teachers will
communicate required attendance with students and guardians. Students may choose to attend the scheduled FCA day to bump up a mark on one major assessment. This must be arranged with the teacher in advance. Guidance Updates -

Semester 2: Requesting Course Changes

- Students who want to request a course change in their Semester 2 schedule will complete an online Google form.
- This form will be posted on the home page of the Governor Simcoe website from Wednesday, January 29th to Friday, February 7th.
- Students must attend all of the classes in which they are currently scheduled and, after they submit the online form, Mrs. Stewart or Mr. Tope will call into one of their classes and ask them to go to the Guidance Office to discuss course options.

Next Year: Course Selections

- Students will choose their courses for next school year (2025-2026) from Monday, February 10th to Tuesday, February 25th.
- Throughout these weeks, Mrs. Stewart and Mr. Tope will meet with one class each period, and they will work individually with

students to assist them with the process.

- The schedule: Period 2 = Grade 11 classes, Period 3 = Grade 10 classes, Period 4 = Grade 9 classes.
- Course selections will be done through Xello, an online platform available through students' DSBN D2L/Brightspace account.
- For your reference, the Guidance Department held Grade Assemblies with each grade in December to review OSSD requirements, compulsory and elective course options, and courses pertaining to post-secondary programs.
- The list of course offerings for next year were handed out to each student at the assembly; they are also available on Simcoe's Guidance website: govsimcoe.dsbn.org>Student Services top tab>Guidance drop down>Information For Grade 9/10/11 (select the appropriate tab)>Next Year's Course Selections.
- Grade 12 students interested in applying for 12B for next year are to watch their Guidance Google Class of 2025 for the 12B application. These are reviewed in late August by the administration.
