AI tools can support educators in personalizing instruction, addressing diverse student needs, and analyzing data to better inform teaching practices.

At the same time, we recognize the need to approach AI thoughtfully. Issues such as data privacy, academic integrity, and ethical use require careful consideration.

To this end, we have formed a Secondary AI Committee made up of system administrators, secondary school administrators, teachers, and data experts. Together, we are developing board-wide guidelines to support responsible and effective AI integration.

Our guidelines will focus on the following key areas: Pedagogical and instructional integration, Academic integrity, Data privacy, Ethical, equitable use and accessibility
