School updates:

National Day for Truth & Reconciliation:

Monday, September 30th is National Day for Truth and Reconciliation - The message behind this day is Every Child Matters and is an opportunity for First Nations, local governments, schools and communities to honour survivors, families and communities. At DSBN we want to encourage all to take the opportunity to talk, teach and learn about residential schools to ensure that the history and legacy remains a vital component of the reconciliation process.

During Simcoe Fest on Friday, Sept 27th, orange shirts were available to any student wanting one. Staff and students were encouraged to add an orange link to create a large paper chain, which is displayed in the main foyer today. This visual link is to demonstrate that everyone is involved in reconciliation, and that every child matters. Student's name and/or message can be added to the link. On September 30th, a playlist of Indigenous artists was playing over the PA before school starts. During lunch, students were invited to participate in placing the orange-painted rocks in Governor Simcoe's front garden to create a display to commemorate the legacy of residential schools. Rocks that were painted last year will be used, and new rocks were available for students to create if they wish to participate.

Literacy (EQAO-OSSLT) - Fall Write:

- Grade 10 students and previously eligible students will write the test on November 19th 21st and then again 26th 28th. This gives us until Dec 5th when the fall window closes to support any student absences.
- Grade 10 English classes (first-time eligible) will write with their teachers during their English class period (with extended time if necessary) between the 19th-21st.
- Previously eligible to write in the library same 2-days
- Other grade 10's not in English this semester will write in small groups between 26th -28th in the library (grouped based on last name)
- Lunch-Time Literacy sessions begin next week which are held twice a week (Tuesday and Thursdays) and then three times a week before the test (all students welcome, specific students invited based on last years grade 9 achievement)
 - Sessions start with general overview, and then practice on isolated skills such as; reading comprehension, short answer, multiple choice, and ending with the opinion essay)
 - Sessions provide students with feedback on their practice work
