

To Parents/Guardians and Student Redcoats -

It is time to do course selection for the school year 2022/23. Students will use the on-line Career Cruising program. The Career Cruising Course Planner helps students plan courses that reflect their career aspirations and graduation requirements. It brings together critical information including credit history, course descriptions, diploma tracking, pre-requisite requirements and suggested courses.

On-line Course Information

An organized, intuitive way to learn about different courses available at our school.

» On-line Course/Career Planning

Students can plan courses for their future based on the careers or post-secondary education institutions they have researched in Career Cruising. Course Planner will also show past courses and grades.

>> Graduation Requirements

Course Planner will track a student plan to determine if the student is meeting graduation requirements. However, please note the program is NOT able to reflect the student's completed community hours, may not count some courses taken from another school, and sometimes has difficulty recognizing co-op credits.

1) At school, students will sign into their DSBN Account and access e-Learning. At home (usin

Chrome), go to http://govsimcoe.dsbn.org/ and log into e+Learning. Enter your DSBN computer login username and password. Once in e+Learning students, in consultation with their parents, will be able to enter the Career Cruising tab to see their options and select their 8 courses (plus 2 alternate courses) for the school year 2022/23. On the Career Cruising main page select Choose My Courses from the left side blue menu (4 tabs down). When you SUBMIT there is a parent sign off sheet. This year we are going paperless. It is understood that you and your parent/guardian have reviewed your course selections together before you submit. Also, don't worry if you and your parents are unsure; you will have the opportunity to discuss your choices with a counsellor. To ensure your spots in courses please submit your courses by Friday, February 11th.

(You are going to want to remember this pathway to research careers, earnings, and post-secondary education down the road!)
