

## **How to read a Course Code:**

**ENG 4U1** (English, 4<sup>th</sup> year, university level)

First three digits = course codes (description under Course Title)

Fourth digit = course year (1 = grade 9, 2 = grade 10, 3= grade 11, 4 = grade 12)

Fifth digit = stream of study/pathway

D=Academic

P = Applied

U=University

O=Open

C=College

M=College/University

E=Workplace

Sixth digit = credit value; unless the sixth digit shows

F = Female Phys. Ed.

F = Study in French Immersion

H = Half credit

M = Male Phys. Ed.

8 = Co-op (2 credits)

**\*Note to university applicants** – To qualify for university entrance, all students must complete at least 6 appropriate Grade 12 (4<sup>th</sup> year) “University” (coded “U”) or “College/University” coded “M” level courses. Universities may require a specific number of U courses and a specific number of M courses within that 6. Make sure you have the appropriate pre-requisite courses for the program you are applying to.
